Requirement to Start	All athletes need a valid startpass from their responsible federation or a signed athletes declaration. They must be on time and have paid the entry fee before they can be issued a start number.
Equipment	All racers have to wear protective equipment (helmet, protection for hand/wrist, elbow, knee, shorts with guards, etc.). Breaks are highly recommended.
Liability	Neither Arranger, nor organizer, nor organizing club, nor officials, nor local government, nor sponsor or any person who is involved in the race can be held responsible for accidents, injuries, harm, damage, breakage or thefts. Competitors take part in the race at their own risk. Racers, including foreign participants, are required to have their own insurance. The race takes place in all weather conditions.
